INSTALLATION OF HIPS FOR BORA BORA MODEL

Hips are used to cover corners and gutters. Use only one hip on every other row.





1) Firstly, cut the edge of the leaf at the junction to get a clean corner angle, cutting from the top rail **following** along the beam and up to the start of the next row (the one just below). THEN, from that point cut at a 60° angle. Fix the rail to the beam.





2) For the other side of the same junction, cut at a 60° angle starting from the top of the rail to the end of the leaf. Fix the rail to the beam.







3) Lay a hip at the center of the vertical beam, starting at the rail. Screw the hip to the beam (minimum two screws).





4) At junctions where hips are not required, go back to step one with the next rail.
